APPLY → GET MATCHED → PREPARE YOUR VISIT → JOIN US @ REI

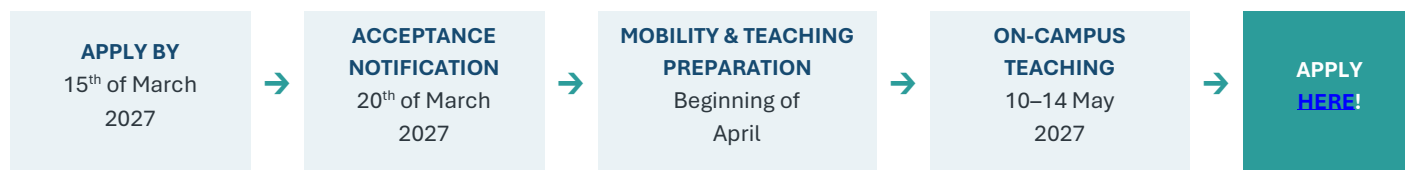
A simple four-step journey from your proposal to teaching at REI:
